VineyardKids First-Fourth Grade involves both large and small group settings—reflecting both the worship and small group ministries offered to the adults of our congregation. The children are in a large group setting for worship and a lesson presentation (drama, storytelling, puppetry, video, etc.). Small groups are organized by grade and led by a small group leader. They facilitate relationship building, accountability, prayer and discipleship. It is our desire to partner with parents in bringing children into relationship with Jesus Christ and helping them to grow in their relationship with Him.

Fifth grade is an important year of transition between grade school and middle school. Fifth graders begin the school year worshipping with VineyardKids First-Fourth Grade and finish the school year worshipping with our middle school ministry (Fusion Middle School). Following worship, they have a Bible lesson and small group discussions geared specifically toward fifth-graders. They join the middle school ministry during the summer months.
