Providing a genuine welcome and accommodating attendees at Vineyard Columbus is a very important part of our weekend worship services. The Hospitality Ministry can use your help, gifts of hospitality, and encouragement to make sure that everyone has a positive worship experience.

### **Ushers:**

*During the weekend services*

Ushers extend a genuine welcome and assist attendees in finding seating for the services as well as facilitate the collection of the offering. Ushers are the stewards over the service should there be a need or an emergency.

### **Welcome Team**

*During the weekend services*

Welcome Team volunteers extend a genuine welcome to attendees entering our building as a first touch in the Hospitality ministry. This position also provides ministry to first time guests as they often need directions coming through the doors.

### **Greeting Team**

*During the weekend services*

Greeting Team volunteers extend a genuine welcome and the bulletin as attendees enter the auditorium.

### **Tithe and Offering Counting Team**

*During the weekend services*

The faithfulness of our congregation in sacrificial giving on a weekly basis brings with it the need for volunteers. These volunteers count and document the offering for each worship service. Membership is required.

### **Guest Connection Team**

*During the weekend services*

The Guest Connection Team is an integral part of reaching out to our first time guests. Being a part of this team involves extending a gift to first time visitors during our service. There is opportunity to serve following the service making a more personal contact and providing an opportunity to answer any questions they may have. Also inviting them to our Welcome Dinner and offering other information on programs, groups and classes that are available through Vineyard Columbus.

### **Worship Service Prep Volunteer**

*Tuesday, Wednesday or Friday, two to three hours any time between 9am-2pm*

There are many details that go into our weekend services. This volunteer position involves assisting with some of these important details including preparation for communion, monitoring the inventory of service items and many other necessary tasks.

**Funeral Ministry Volunteer**

At Vineyard Columbus we come along side of those that have lost loved ones. We offer many services including grief support groups, counseling and in our Hospitality ministry we also host Funerals and Memorials for our members and their immediate families, when requested. Occasionally we also hold receptions after bereavement services. This volunteer position involves using your gift of hospitality for these receptions.
